

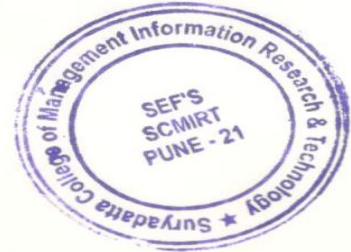
A guest lecture on Cyber Bulling -A Report

The students become aware of the actual functioning of a business firm, its manufacturing process and related issues. They acquire practical knowledge which aids in better understanding of their theory syllabus.

Suryadatta

College of Management Information Research & Technology, Bavdhan, Pune organized Industrial Visit to Parle Factory, Khopoli, Pune on 18th October, 2023.

Student Learning Objectives of the Visit:

1. To study work environment of the Company,
2. To understand the working of the company and various organizational processes.
3. To learn about the products being manufactured, technology in use, capacity of the plant, production planning via demand forecasting, Costing, Supply chain, HRM, Marketing & Finance, alongwith the vision and strengths of the company.

Brief Company Profile:

The first Parle Factory was set up in 1929 in Mumbai when India was ruled by Britain. Shri. Mohanlal Dayal of Surat alongwith Shri Narottam set up a candies and confectionary unit. A decade later it was upgraded to manufacture biscuits as well. More factories were set up in Bangalore, Bahadurgarh in

Haryana and Neemrana in Rajasthan.

The Parle Factory at Khopoli manufactures 75 metric tons of Parle-G biscuits and 85 metric tons of other varieties per day. Manpower employed is 750. The company is a food manufacturer under FMCG sector. The raw materials used are wheat flour, oils, fats, milk, sugar.

Production Process:-- The ingredients quality evaluation is done and then they are mixed, moulded, baked, cooled and finally packaged. They are distributed to the wholesalers. The baking process consists of caramelisation and baking at 240 degree centigrade.

The factory has four plants with plant 1 & 2 manufacturing Parle-G and cracker variety biscuits, and plants 3 & 4 manufacturing premium biscuits like chocolate and milk products and centre-filled varieties. Just In Time and Kaizen processes are used. Bifurcation is done based on quality and for detecting presence of any foreign matter in the product. Variance analysis is used on monthly basis and Production planning detail schedule (PPDS) is prepared for weekly output under logistics department. Systems Application and Products in Data Processing(SAPS) is set up in the factory for monthly forecasting of demand.

The Parle products are exported to 73 countries. The Krackjack is the world's first Sweet & Salty biscuit (1972). The strength of Parle company is "No Compromise In Quality", for which it has been awarded.

What was Observed and Learned:

The Industrial visit to **Parle Factory** was a good learning experience for the students. They gained an insight into the overall production process, administration and management of Parle products. The 80 SCMIT students along with faculty were first seated in the auditorium where the officials Shri Ravi Deshmukh and Shri. Satish Patil welcomed them and explained the historical background of Parle factory.

Later the Export Production Head Mr. Gajendra Jawale explained the whole process from procurement of the raw materials, their quality assessment, technology, processes of procurement, techniques of procurement of material, production, packaging and finally dispatch in that he explained supply chain logistic management of the company.

He also explained the costing techniques are being used in company like standard Costing, Budgetary Control, Variance analysis, EOQ technique for increasing the efficiency of the production. He also explained the HR requirement for Production Unit like they require B.Tech which they hire from Nokari.com and administrative or management staff they recruit from their Head office which is located in Mumbai. Question answer session followed and the doubts of students got answered satisfactorily. The Official was felicitated by Shilpa Ma'am and pictures taken.

The students were shown the plant and process of manufacturing Hide and Seek biscuits which was very enlightening. The company offered freshly manufactured biscuits . We thanked the officials for their valuable time and hosting of the visit, and the knowledge gained by the students.

To understand the evolution and making of Reserve bank of India

Brief Company Profile:

The archives museum was inaugurated on 1 June 2010 under the governorship of Dr Duvvuri Subbarao. The museum was established on the occasion of RBI completing 75 years of its existence. The museum houses documents from the Archives on themes relating to the history of RBI and some artefacts received from Central Office Departments and Regional Offices of the Bank

What was observed and learned?

The museum nestled among a vast expanse of nature holds decades old records and artefacts from even before independence.

Promissory notes dating back to 1926, letters written by calligraphers, minutes of proceedings, newspaper clippings and notices that were circulated were beautifully preserved and displayed. It also included letters from eminent personalities like APJ Abdul Kalam and Indira Gandhi.

The Reserve Bank of India played and still plays an important role in agricultural credit and an entire section of the museum was curated to display the evolution of agri sector credit.

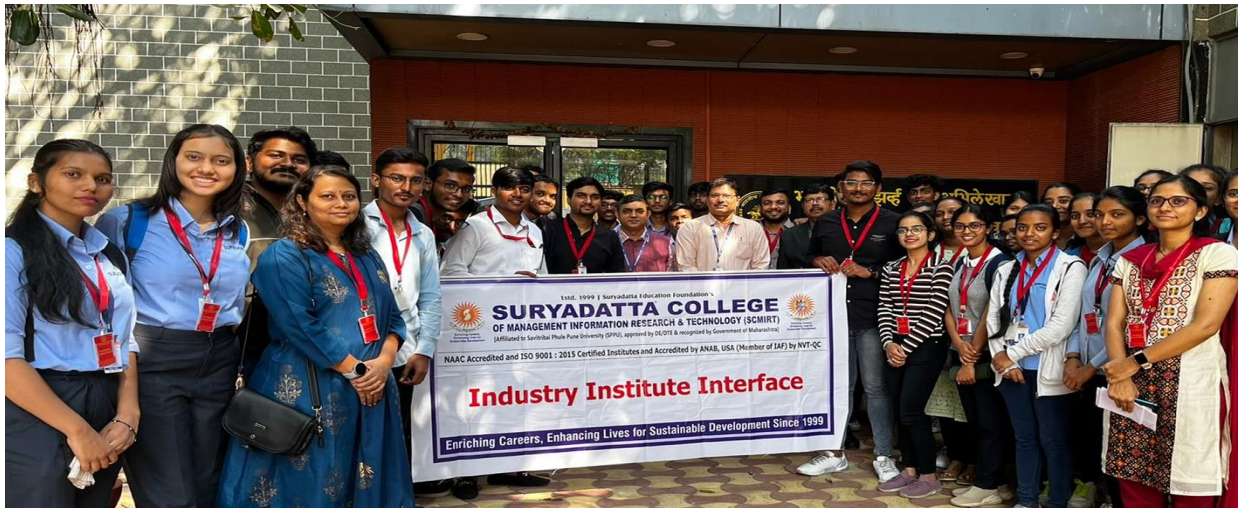
It uses scientific preservation of records such as microfilming and digitisation to preserve the documents collected.

The entire visit was guided by Sahu Sir and Singh Sir, while dispensing valuable knowledge regarding the archives along the way. Singh Sir briefed us on how students can enter RBI as a

career prospect and shed light on different examinations through which graduates can work for the Reserve Bank of India.

The Campus also houses College of Agricultural banking which is also an institute for the purposes of training for new recruits of the Reserve Bank.

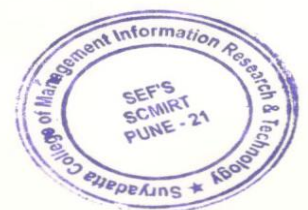
Speaking of the visit in a nutshell, today's experience provided a peek through a window to the central bank of India and its control over the financial system.
