





# Memorandum of Understanding

Entered into and between

Association of Internal Control Practitioners

Risk Management Association of India

and

Suryadatta Group of Institutes

(June 2020)

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## 1. Parties

- i. The Association of Internal Control Practitioners whose address is 71-75 Shelton Street, Covent Garden, London, WC2H 9JQ hereinafter referred to as '**The AICP**'.
- ii. Suryadatta Group of Institutes whose address is Bavdhan, Pune 411021, Maharashtra, India, herein referred to as '**Suryadatta**'.
- iii. The Risk Management Association of India, whose address is 25/1, Baranashi Ghosh Street, Near Girish Park Metro, Kolkata – 700007 hereinafter referred to as '**RMAI**'.

Hereinafter referred to as 'Party' or 'Parties'.

## 2. Preamble and Purpose of the Agreement

- a) **The AICP** is a certification and training institute engaged in internal control, risk management, corporate governance, and procurement and supply chain management practices.
- b) **Suryadatta** is a group of educational institutions conducting varied academic disciplines.
- c) **RMAI** is a specialist training institute engaged in risk management practices and is a joint certifying body in conjunction with the AICP.
- d) The Parties are desirous of establishing formal collaboration aimed at delivering professional certification and training in internal control, enterprise wide risk management, corporate governance, procurement and supply chain practices and allied professional practices throughout India and Asia.
- e) Except where expressly stated to the contrary, this MoU is intended to provide a framework for the Parties to collaborate in imparting The AICP and RMAI education, certification, and training services.
- f) The Parties, in the spirit of cooperation agree in principle to share their resources, plans and agenda in an open, transparent, and candid collaborative partnership by jointly supporting and promoting the highest standards of skills development, professional integrity, and ethics.
- g) In pursuit of these goals the AICP shall, as the initial building block in the development of their relationship, take the necessary steps for Suryadatta to use the AICP individual Professional Certification materials, i.e. the intellectual property, namely;
  - i. Certified Risk & Internal Control Professional (CRICP)
  - ii. Certified Procurement & Supply Chain Professional (CPSCP)
- h) RMAI will make available their Risk Management programmes for delivery by Suryadatta at the appropriate time.



- i) The first step in the cooperation of the Parties will be to harness a broad understanding and attending benefits; encourage good faith and openness in providing and exchanging the desired knowledge and expertise; and establish a mutually beneficial, on-going working relationship. Separate and specific individual memoranda of agreement may be entered into from time to time by the Parties in giving effect to the terms of this memorandum of understanding.

### 3. Undertakings

#### a) Consultation

Each Party will nominate a person (representative) in relation to the performance of the collaborative activities as agreed in this MOU. The Parties undertake through their authorised representatives to ensure adequate communications are maintained in order to evaluate the implementation of this memorandum, discuss common issues relevant to this memorandum and to decide on necessary changes or additions thereto.

#### a) Dispute Resolution

The Parties shall attempt to resolve any dispute arising out of or relating to this agreement through negotiations between senior executives of the Parties who have authority to settle the same. The rights and obligations of the Parties are neither assignable nor transferable except after written consent of the Parties.

### 4. Amendments

Any material amendments to this Memorandum of Understanding may be initiated by either Party. The desired amendments shall be negotiated between the Parties and such amendments shall not be in force or in effect unless agreed by the Parties in writing.

### 5. Obligations

#### a) The AICP & the RMAI

- i. The AICP and RMAI undertakes to cooperate with Suryadatta and will not conceal wholly or in part any information or detail necessary for the effective implementation of the activities to be carried out in terms of this memorandum. The AICP and RMAI will provide Suryadatta with reasonable support in satisfying all the steps to be fulfilled to meet these obligations.
- ii. In addition the AICP and RMAI agrees to avail from time to time additional information, professional and technical advice necessary for the implementation of any activities of this memorandum.
- iii. The AICP and RMAI will make available to Suryadatta additional relevant courses and allied professional courses which they may opt to include in their curriculum.



- iv. RMAI shall support Suryadatta and the AICP in consultation, collective discussions on collaboration and administration management as appropriate.

## b) Suryadatta

- i. Suryadatta shall adopt and maintain the AICP professional certification programme in terms of content, structures and assessment of candidates and ensure the protection and proper use of any intellectual property rights arising from any of the activities of its collaboration with the AICP.
- ii. Suryadatta will ensure all AICP and RMAI course Certificates issued to successful candidates carry the joint branding of the AICP and RMAI.
- iii. Suryadatta will appoint a coordinator mandated to facilitate and manage the activities necessary to give effect to this memorandum and, in its dealings with the AICP, to do so through its authorised representatives.

## 6. Duration and Termination

The Parties agree that this Memorandum of Understanding shall become effective on the date that it is signed by the Parties and shall remain in force unless written notification of termination is received by either Party at least three months prior to the date of termination. Any changes or alterations to this memorandum of understanding shall be subject to the written consent of all Parties.

## 7. Confidentiality

Confidential information may be exchanged between the parties in connection with this MOU and for the purposes of the proposed collaboration. Each Party (receiving Party) agrees to keep and maintain the confidential information of the other Party (disclosing Party) at all times.

A Party will not be in breach of this clause 7 where confidential information is required by law or regulation to be disclosed to an appropriate authority, provided that the Party so required prior to such disclosure promptly notifies the Party to whom the confidential information belongs.

## 8. Notices


Any notice, demand, offer or other written instrument required or permitted to be given pursuant to this MOU shall be in writing, signed by the Party giving such notice and shall be sent by e-mail.

Each Party shall have the right to change the place to which notice shall be sent or delivered or to specify one additional email address to which copies of notices may be sent and delivered to the other Party.

## 9. Force Majeure

If either party is affected by Force Majeure it shall notify the other party within seven days of the nature and extent of the circumstances in question.

Neither party shall be liable to the other or be deemed to be in breach of this MoU by reason of any delay in performing or any failure to perform any of its obligations if the delay or failure was beyond the parties' reasonable control. Without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing the following shall be regarded as causes beyond either parties' reasonable control:


- i. Act of God, explosion, flood, tempest, fire, or accident;
- ii. War or threat of war, sabotage, insurrection, civil disturbance, or requisition;
- iii. Acts, restrictions, regulations, byelaws, prohibitions, or measures of any kind on the part of any governmental parliamentary or local authority.

## 10. Preliminary Understanding

This MoU sets out the preliminary intentions of each Party with respect to the proposed arrangement and to assist them to work out commercial details so that the preparation and finalisation of a formal development agreement based on these general terms can proceed at an appointed time. In witness hereof, the parties have caused this Memorandum of Understanding to be executed by their duly authorized representatives.




Now this memorandum of understanding witnesses as follows:




9. Arrangements for common teaching with other programmes of study;
10. Title of the award/Training Programme;
11. Full syllabus which includes a complete list of course modules;
12. Clear description of standards required for assessment grades to be awarded;
13. Complete assessment model;
14. One sample assessment, associated marking schemes and specimen answers for each module;
15. Name and contact details of Accredited Partner person responsible for validation of the programme;
16. Procedures for approving and moderating question papers;
17. Examination regulations and procedures to ensure question paper and examination security;
18. Procedures for appointing assessment markers;
19. Procedures for internally moderating marking of assessments/scripts;
20. Procedures for issuing accurate results on time and keeping effective student records where awards can be gained over time by the accumulation of module grades etc;
21. schedules and deadlines for any validation/moderation process to clearly identify that there is sufficient time for approval of results and issuing of certificates.

## Annual Re-Validation



**PREAMBLE:**

This MOU established with the view of promoting cooperation in academic education and research between SEF's, SURYADATTA GROUP OF INSTITUTES (SGI) and the LINCOLN UNIVERSITY COLLEGE (collectively referred to as parties) establishes as basis for their further cooperation in academic in the following below mentioned areas.

Whereas the parties wish to explore and establish a basis for their further cooperation in the areas of mutual interest and agrees as follows:

**GENERAL SCOPE:** Both parties contemplated the academic alliance through:

1. Appointment of research guides from Suryadatta Group of Institutes to guide the PhD aspirants from across the globe

4. In case of various PG courses having trimester pattern, 4 trimesters (T1 to T4) teaching at SGI, Pune, India and one trimester (T5/T6) internship in SGI, Pune, India and other trimester (T5/T6) internship in LUC Malaysia or both the trimesters (T5/T6) internship in LUC Malaysia.
5. To initiate possible twinning program for various UG & PG Courses in the various field as mentioned above, based on credit transfer.

9. Joint research in areas of mutual interest
10. Exchange of students for appropriate leave of study and research
11. Organizing symposia, workshops, conferences, award ceremony and meetings
12. Sharing of experiences in innovative teaching methods and courses design
13. Exchange of academic publication and reports.
14. Conduct MDP, FDP & consultancy project


Lincoln University Malaysia (LUC) will also initiate and provide necessary assistance under this agreement for tie-up/collaboration with any other Universities on similar pattern.

Specific activities and programs implemented under authority of this MOU shall be subject to availability of funds and the approval of each parties authorized representatives.

**SEPARATE AGREEMENTS:** Prior to initiating any specific activity or programs, the parties will negotiate and enter in to a definite agreement within one month's duration signed by each party's authorized signatory, describing the terms of the arrangement, including but not limited to financial commitments, academic freedom commitments, immigration and compliance obligation and details of the exchange or collaborative relationship. 


Both the parties will update each other about developments regarding new affiliation, collaboration, tie-up, new opportunity if any during the period of the agreement.



## 1. Parties

- i. The Association of Internal Control Practitioners whose address is 71-75 Shelton Street, Covent Garden, London, WC2H 9JQ hereinafter referred to as '**The AICP**'.
- ii. Suryadatta Group of Institutes whose address is Bavdhan, Pune 411021, Maharashtra, India, herein referred to as '**Suryadatta**'.
- iii. The Risk Management Association of India, whose address is 25/1, Baranashi Ghosh Street, Near Girish Park Metro, Kolkata – 700007 hereinafter referred to as '**RMAI**'.

Hereinafter referred to as 'Party' or 'Parties'.

## 2. Preamble and Purpose of the Agreement

- a) **The AICP** is a certification and training institute engaged in internal control, risk management, corporate governance, and procurement and supply chain management practices.
- b) **Suryadatta** is a group of educational institutions conducting varied academic disciplines.
- c) **RMAI** is a specialist training institute engaged in risk management practices and is a joint certifying body in conjunction with the AICP.
- d) The Parties are desirous of establishing formal collaboration aimed at delivering professional certification and training in internal control, enterprise wide risk management, corporate governance, procurement and supply chain practices and allied professional practices throughout India and Asia.
- e) Except where expressly stated to the contrary, this MoU is intended to provide a framework for the Parties to collaborate in imparting The AICP and RMAI education, certification, and training services.
- f) The Parties, in the spirit of cooperation agree in principle to share their resources, plans and agenda in an open, transparent, and candid collaborative partnership by jointly supporting and promoting the highest standards of skills development, professional integrity, and ethics.
- g) In pursuit of these goals the AICP shall, as the initial building block in the development of their relationship, take the necessary steps for Suryadatta to use the AICP individual Professional Certification materials, i.e. the intellectual property, namely;
  - i. Certified Risk & Internal Control Professional (CRICP)
  - ii. Certified Procurement & Supply Chain Professional (CPSCP)
- h) RMAI will make available their Risk Management programmes for delivery by Suryadatta at the appropriate time.



- i) The first step in the cooperation of the Parties will be to harness a broad understanding and attending benefits; encourage good faith and openness in providing and exchanging the desired knowledge and expertise; and establish a mutually beneficial, on-going working relationship. Separate and specific individual memoranda of agreement may be entered into from time to time by the Parties in giving effect to the terms of this memorandum of understanding.

### 3. Undertakings

#### a) Consultation

Each Party will nominate a person (representative) in relation to the performance of the collaborative activities as agreed in this MOU. The Parties undertake through their authorised representatives to ensure adequate communications are maintained in order to evaluate the implementation of this memorandum, discuss common issues relevant to this memorandum and to decide on necessary changes or additions thereto.

#### a) Dispute Resolution

The Parties shall attempt to resolve any dispute arising out of or relating to this agreement through negotiations between senior executives of the Parties who have authority to settle the same. The rights and obligations of the Parties are neither assignable nor transferable except after written consent of the Parties.

### 4. Amendments

Any material amendments to this Memorandum of Understanding may be initiated by either Party. The desired amendments shall be negotiated between the Parties and such amendments shall not be in force or in effect unless agreed by the Parties in writing.

### 5. Obligations

#### a) The AICP & the RMAI

- i. The AICP and RMAI undertakes to cooperate with Suryadatta and will not conceal wholly or in part any information or detail necessary for the effective implementation of the activities to be carried out in terms of this memorandum. The AICP and RMAI will provide Suryadatta with reasonable support in satisfying all the steps to be fulfilled to meet these obligations.
- ii. In addition the AICP and RMAI agrees to avail from time to time additional information, professional and technical advice necessary for the implementation of any activities of this memorandum.
- iii. The AICP and RMAI will make available to Suryadatta additional relevant courses and allied professional courses which they may opt to include in their curriculum.



- iv. RMAI shall support Suryadatta and the AICP in consultation, collective discussions on collaboration and administration management as appropriate.

## b) Suryadatta

- i. Suryadatta shall adopt and maintain the AICP professional certification programme in terms of content, structures and assessment of candidates and ensure the protection and proper use of any intellectual property rights arising from any of the activities of its collaboration with the AICP.
- ii. Suryadatta will ensure all AICP and RMAI course Certificates issued to successful candidates carry the joint branding of the AICP and RMAI.
- iii. Suryadatta will appoint a coordinator mandated to facilitate and manage the activities necessary to give effect to this memorandum and, in its dealings with the AICP, to do so through its authorised representatives.

## 6. Duration and Termination

The Parties agree that this Memorandum of Understanding shall become effective on the date that it is signed by the Parties and shall remain in force unless written notification of termination is received by either Party at least three months prior to the date of termination. Any changes or alterations to this memorandum of understanding shall be subject to the written consent of all Parties.

## 7. Confidentiality

Confidential information may be exchanged between the parties in connection with this MOU and for the purposes of the proposed collaboration. Each Party (receiving Party) agrees to keep and maintain the confidential information of the other Party (disclosing Party) at all times.

A Party will not be in breach of this clause 7 where confidential information is required by law or regulation to be disclosed to an appropriate authority, provided that the Party so required prior to such disclosure promptly notifies the Party to whom the confidential information belongs.

## 8. Notices

Any notice, demand, offer or other written instrument required or permitted to be given pursuant to this MOU shall be in writing, signed by the Party giving such notice and shall be sent by e-mail.

If either party is affected by Force Majeure it shall notify the other party within seven days of the nature and extent of the circumstances in question.

Neither party shall be liable to the other or be deemed to be in breach of this MoU by reason of any delay in performing or any failure to perform any of its obligations if the delay or failure was beyond the parties' reasonable control. Without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing the following shall be regarded as causes beyond either parties' reasonable control:


- i. Act of God, explosion, flood, tempest, fire, or accident;

The signatories to this memorandum assert they have been authorised by their respective institutions to enter into this framework relationship with each other.


