

5. SAVE SOIL MOVEMENT with SADGURU :




8. International Co-operative Day :



A powerful quote, quoted by Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar, originally named as Dr. Bhimrao Ramji Ambedkar, who was a visionary and social reformer played a significant role in shaping modern India. Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar was born on 14th April 1891 in a small village of Maharashtra. He belonged to Mahar caste, considered to be one of the lowest caste in Indian society during that time. Despite facing discrimination and social barrier, Ambedkar went to become one of the most influential leader in Indian history. He was a lawyer, economist, educationist, and social activist. He was the first Indian to pursue a doctorate in economics from a foreign university. He was also a prominent leader of Dalit community. Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar is best known as the chief architect of the Indian constitution, as he played a key role in drafting of the Indian constitution, which included provisions to ensure equality and justice for all citizens, regardless of their caste or religion. He founded the "Balishkrit Hitakarini Sabha" to work for the social
