Cleanliness Drive, emphasizing the profound link between cleanliness and well-being. The participants were organized into groups, each responsible for specific areas along the route.



Impact on Women:

The consequence so sexual harassment extends far beyond immediate is comfort, often leading to psychological distress, decreased job satisfaction, and professional stagnation. Fear of retaliation and the stigma associated with reporting further exacerbate the trauma, Perpetuating a culture of silence and impunity.

Legal Framework:

While laws and policies exist to protect employees from harassment, enforcement Mechanisms and institutional accountability mechanisms remain inadequate. Strengthening legal protections, enhancing enforcement efforts, and promoting a culture of zero tolerance are essential to safeguarding women's rights in the work place.


